

## Supplementary Mooring Details

An additional mooring area has been designated on the foreshore, adjacent to Peter's Tower, for punts/tenders that cannot be accommodated in the summer boat park.

If the Harbour Board allocates you a mooring in this area the requirements for ground equipment can be simplified from our existing requirements for moorings on our fundus.

Basically, two concrete sinkers are to be buried in the foreshore at least 200mm beneath the surface, and no more than 3 metres apart, parallel to the edge of the foreshore.

A light chain or suitable rope is to be securely fastened to each sinker, and joined together at a single pick-up buoy, which must be visible at high tide. The punt/tender will be moored at its bow end only and will swing with wind and tide.

An acceptable size for a sinker can be cast in a builder's bucket using pre-mixed concrete from a builder's merchant. A fixing to take a shackle must be cast into the concrete sinker.
